



Student Ministry Intern, Summer 2026

Allisonville Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Indianapolis, Indiana, is seeking applicants for a Student Ministry Intern for the summer of 2026. Applicants must have completed at least their junior year of college by the time the internship begins. Applications will be accepted from undergraduate and graduate students.

The Student Ministry Intern will be supervised by the Associate Minister of Faith Formation and primarily serve in the Youth Ministry of Allisonville Christian Church by supporting our summer ministries, but the intern will have the opportunity to work with and shadow other Allisonville ministers and staff. The internship begins on **May 26** and runs until **August 10**. The start and end dates may be slightly adjusted to accommodate the intern's academic calendar.

The intern will generally work full-time throughout the week and may take up to one week of vacation time, provided it is communicated in advance with the Associate Minister of Faith Formation. The intern will also be able to have a designated day off during the week. Housing will be provided by Allisonville and the intern will receive **\$8,000** over the course of the summer. Bringing a car is highly recommended, however accommodations can be made if the intern cannot.

Job Responsibilities Include:

- Working collaboratively with ACC's youth ministry staff and leaders to lead and support summer programming
- Participating as an adult chaperone on both youth summer mission trips
- Planning and leading at least one youth ministry summer event per month
- Planning and leading Bible studies for the youth ministry
- Assisting in ACC's Vacation Bible School
- Assisting with administrative tasks and special projects for the wider Faith Formation ministry
- Attending relevant ACC staff meetings
- Participating in worship leadership on Sunday mornings (9:30 and 11:00)
- Shadowing other ministers and staff at ACC to learn more about other aspects of congregational ministry

Optional Opportunities Include:

- Counseling church camp at Camp Bedford, the camp of the Christian Church in Indiana
- Connecting with Christian Theological Seminary, a Disciples of Christ seminary in Indianapolis near ACC
- Participating in other ministries in the life of ACC such as: Children's Ministry, Young Adult Ministry, Prime Timers (senior adult ministry), Green Chalice Team, ACC Creation Care Garden, Music Ministry, and more
- Joining other ACC ministers on pastoral care visits and calls
